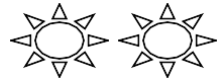


Summer Session 2026

1. Regular Credit Courses

Salary: \$2,798.48 (includes teacher prep time)

Dates: June 30-July 17

4. ELL Courses
Salary: \$2,798.48 (includes teacher prep time)

Dates: June 30-July 17
Time: 08:45am-12:15pm

These courses provide students at the secondary level with the opportunity for English language improvement with a focus on speaking, listening, reading and writing skills. Previous teaching experience related to balanced literacy is required.

5. Grade 7 Transition: Going into Grade 8
Salary: \$2,798.48 (includes teacher prep time)

Dates: June 30-July 17
Time: 08:45am-12:15pm

This course provides students on their way to secondary school in the fall with an introduction to Grade 8 Mathematics and English with an emphasis on research and study skills. Students will develop skills and strategies to enhance their Grade 8 experience, such as research, note-taking, presentation of learning, organization, literacy, numeracy and the writing process. Students must have completed Grade 7.

6. Enrichment courses
Salary: \$2,798.48 (includes teacher prep time)

Dates: June 30-July 17
Time: 08:45am-12:15pm

Aligned with the redesigned curriculum, these courses are **an** introduction to courses that will be offered in senior grades during the regular school year. Courses such as coding, pre-engineering, catering and musical theatre are some of the opportunities we hope to provide at the Grade 8 & 9 level.

7. Teacher Librarian(s)
Salary: \$4,197.70 (includes teacher prep time)

Dates: June 30-July 24

The Teacher Librarian(s) will be responsible for developing a library/resource support program to assist Summer Session teachers and students taking credits programs and/or ELL programs. Along with the Summer Session Principal, the Teacher Librarian(s) will be responsible for liaison with regular school administrators and teacher librarians to ensure effective and appropriate use of school and district resources. Some support for afternoon programs will be required.
